Principal's Report

- We received \$1000 grant from the Campbell's Soup
- Practicing for Badger Exams – Next Monday all 1st – 5th grade students will start taking this exam. Will be a great test for the kids to make sure we are meeting the requirements. This exam is a 1 year exam. Will get the results back in a matter of weeks. Dr. Edmond will make sure the parents will know when the students will be taking the exams. Will be about 7 hours of testing, will be performed in 1.5 hour segments with breaks.
- State Budget: Parents are starting to speak with the legislators and the legislators are saying that they are pro-school and that they are assuring us that there will be funds in the budget for schools. Dr. Edmond is optimistic that there will be money put back into the budget for schools.
- We are only projecting 75 students coming from Willow and Woodside is projecting 4 classes for the incoming kindergarteners.
